### **Mission**

1. Advance KARATE in Latvia.
2. Honing of mind, conditioning of body, developing focus and mental energy.

### **Competition rules**

- 1. Kata and Kumite, Team Kata**, disciplines will be judged by the **ITKF** rules. There might be slight deviations, referred to in the competition regulation, as well as judges' meeting before the competition.

*It is the obligation of the coach to explain to the athlete the rules of the discipline that he or she is about to participate in.*

- 2.** Participants shall be allowed to participate in an age group above their actual age, but not allowed to participate in an age group below their age.
- 3.** Participation in more than one **Kata, Kumite, Team Kata** age group shall not be allowed.
- 4.** **Kata and Team Kata** shall be judged by the scoring system.
- 5.** The **Kata** in the finals shall be different from that of pre-finals, except for 10 kyu and 9 kyu.
- 6.** For **Team Kata** discipline, performance requirements for the preliminaries include kata itself, performance requirements for the finals include kata and bunkai.
  - 6.1. Bunkai options: 2 double attacks – defence;  
1 double, 3 simple attacks – defence.
- 7. Kumite**
  - 7.1. JIUY Kumite is allowed from 10 years of age and up.
  - 7.2. Contest match is finished with an athlete being awarded one IPPON or two WAZARI.
  - 7.3. The event host will provide the contestants with protective gloves and white or red belts.
  - 7.4. Advised personal safety equipment;
    - 7.4.1. Kappa (mouth guard).
    - 7.4.2. Women/girls – chest protector, groin protector.
    - 7.4.3. Men/boys – groin protector.
- 8.** In the case when there are less than three participants within an age group, this group will be merged.
- 9.** The participants will bear responsibility for their insurance and the status of their health during the competition. The parents or the coach on the athlete shall assume this responsibility when the athlete is minor.
- 10.** Judges:
  - 10.1. The chief competition judge shall be Renārs Reimandovs.
  - 10.2. Each club shall delegate a minimum of one judge. It is desirable to delegate two or more judges.
- 11.** Awards: top three winners will be awarded by diplomas and medals.
- 12.** Participation fees
  - 12.1. One discipline LVL 6
  - 12.2. Two disciplines LVL 10

- 12.3. Team Kata, a discipline per one team LVL 12  
12.4. Families of 3 persons and up shall receive a participation fee discount up to 50%.  
12.5. The participation fees by each team shall be paid up by the start of the competition.
